

Shell LiveWIRE is Shell's flagship enterprise development programme, delivered in partnership with TEGAS to strengthen local economies across the globe by promoting entrepreneurship, inspiring young entrepreneurs to innovate and produce real business solutions that meet today's socio-economic needs.

Ten startups are shortlisted from the five-day bootcamp to participate in the final pitching session, in which five winning enterprises received a start-up fund of RM10,000 from Shell and an additional RM5,000 from TEGAS, as well as a year of business coaching and opportunities to connect with the global LiveWIRE ecosystem.

The five winners were selected to join Sarawak Shell LiveWIRE 2023 National Level, to compete alongside 5 winners from Sabah Shell LiveWIRE and 5 winners from Peninsula Shell LiveWIRE.

Pungu Borneo was selected as one of the 5 national winners and received a start-up fund of RM30,000 from Shell and an additional RM20,000 from TEGAS. Pungu Borneo also stood a chance to compete in the annual Shell Global Top Ten Innovators Awards.

Pungu Borneo, a social enterprise centred on traditional handicraft and jewelry and culture, was selected as one of the 5 national winners and received a start-up fund of RM30,000 from Shell and an additional RM20,000 from TEGAS. Pungu Borneo also stood a chance to compete in the annual Shell Global Top Ten Innovators Awards.

Headed by Lucille Awen Jon, her efforts on exploring more about crafts and traditional art started in 2014, and since then, has achieved several successes in her entrepreneurship journey thanks to Shell LiveWIRE as well as support from TEGAS.





PRE-ACCELERATOR BOOTCAMP

TEGAS Pre-Accelerator Bootcamp is a one week programme designed to take early-stage startups to the next level. Participants selected for the programme received the benefits of mentoring from industry experts and seasoned entrepreneurs, access to early stage investment opportunities, a green lane to participate in TEGAS accelerator programmes, company incorporation support, 3-month free co-working access to TEGAS Digital Village in Kuching and TEGAS Digital Innovation Hub in Bintulu and Miri, as well as access to startup supports and entrepreneurial ecosystem via TEGAS and MYStartup.

Ten startups were selected for the Demo Day pitching in which five winners wins startup fund amounting to RM2,500 each from MYStartup.





Lavindar Singh of Satok Bridge Digital spoke to TEGAS on their growth since their establishment, upcoming strategic initiatives as well as strategies for achieving long-term sustainable growth.

SATOK BRIDGE DIGITAL

The Journey of Startup Success in Sarawak's Tech Scene

AFTER 15 years of collective experience working outside of Sarawak, it is high time for Lavindar Singh to come back and serve in his beloved hometown, the Land of Hornbill, to contribute his skills and expertise.

The founder of Satok Bridge Digital admitted that the path to establishing a startup wasn't as rosy as it seems, with no clear directions at that point of time.

However, with the consistent encouragement from Tabung Ekonomi Gagasan Anak Sarawak (TEGAS), which Singh likened it to as a 'lifesaver', Satok Bridge Digital joined both MYHackathon and Shell LiveWIRE programs, where they emerged victorious in both competitions. This clearly shows a remarkable achievement for such a young startup which was just founded in 2022.

Why Satok Bridge Digital you ask? Singh explained that it is a spin-off from Satok Bridge Area Consulting Engineers and it is a two separate entities from his partner's company name.

"And that's what kickstarted Satok Bridge Digital. We spent about 15 years working outside of Sarawak, in Kuala Lumpur and other places to name a few.

"Satok Bridge Digital is like our way of building something that we can give back to Sarawak, through whatever skills we have," he shared.

Doubling Team Structure Over The Years

The Satok Bridge Digital team has grown and doubled since 2023. From just three individuals in a one-shared working suite, Singh said the startup saw an addition of 4 employees from the TEGAS Tech Immersion Programme (TTIP).

He said the engineering part is expanding this year, with individuals from TTIP being absorbed into the team, each focusing on their respective disciplines namely software development, especially on UX/UI and mobile app development, artificial intelligence (AI) as well as IoT hardware.

Satok Bridge Digital set its base at TEGAS Digital Village here and now occupies two working spaces to accommodate the current growth of the company.

No Such Things As Competition, Just The First Of Its Kind

So, what sets Satok Bridge Digital apart from the rest? Singh said they are unique in a sense that they are focusing on wildlife technology, via GajahSafe, a security solution to minimize human-wildlife conflict, in which he said not one startup in Malaysia is venturing into that yet.

“In addition to that, with IoT, where we built our own IoT systems and hardware through DataBridge, one of our services for any IoT related projects, we have not seen anyone locally in Sarawak who’s doing that as of yet.

“Therefore, I don’t see others as my competitors but more of a group of people who are trying to hustle and do the same thing as us in the startup landscape,” he said.

As Satok Bridge Digital is also venturing into the agriculture space through EasyGrow, an innovative solution for home farming, he said the products offered by them will benefit mainly plantations, farmers and also those from aquaculture industry.



“TEGAS Is A Lifesaver”

Reiterating this, he said TEGAS is a ‘savior’ to Satok Bridge Digital, allowing them to kickstart their startup with clear direction and also through the TTIP program, which allows Singh to meet local talents that are contributing to the organization today.

“That was one of the main reasons why we came back (to Kuching), as part of giving back to our people.

“Over the six months with TTIP participants, we have polished the talents to their full capabilities and potential and it is only right to absorb them as employees of the organization,” he said.

Singh added that TEGAS also shine the spotlight on startups here, providing them with exposure through visits and various programs implemented by TEGAS.

“It’s a great environment to be in. In TEGAS Digital Village, there are other startups as well where we can also exchange ideas among each other,” he said.



Key Milestones For The Upcoming Months

According to Singh, the focus now is on its two running projects set this April, which he deemed as a 'challenge' for the team, adding "it's a good start for the team" to kick off the year.

Opportunities are aplenty for Satok Bridge Digital, he said, with interested parties looking forward to their wildlife protection services and several pilot projects coming up soon.



Impact That Matters

Singh emphasized that growth is not just in terms of manpower but in terms of the impact they've created to each and every project implemented.

"We do not gamble on a project if we think it is a white elephant project. We want something that is long term and benefits the client, not a wishlist for someone.

"That's more impactful to us because it brings more benefits to the client.

"Our sustainable growth will mainly focus on the long term impact it has on the clients using the data that they have and the digital protection they can get," he stressed.

Honesty Is The Best Policy

When asked for advice for inspiring startups, Singh reminded that there will be a lot of risk involved, sleepless nights, brainstorming and being busy all the time.

"It goes back to the aim and objectives of starting a startup. If you stick to your aim and objective, you will definitely get somewhere.

"We realized that being honest, too, is one of the attributes that help us in our entrepreneurial journey. Being honest with clients and everyone around us has always helped us," he said.

RM71 mil for digital co-living facility

KUCHING: The Sarawak government has approved funding for the construction of the Tabung Ekonomi Gugusan Anak Sarawak (TEGAS) Digital Co-Living Lodge, a first-of-its-kind initiative in digital communal living.

Minister Datuk Patinggi Tan Sri Mahat Zaini Tun Openg said the lodge's strategic location adjacent to the Sarawak Industrial Village (TSD) in Sama Jaya Free Industrial Zone.

The initiative is designed to support researchers, particularly students engaged in projects at TEGAS, by providing them with an opportunity to live together.

"It will also be the first facility of its kind in Borneo. It includes a co-living space, corporate facilities such as a gymnasium, mini studio among other things," said Zaini, adding that the facility will be built within a period of 36 months.

He made the announcement when officiating at the Sarawak Career and Training Fair 2023 (5-Cat) 2022-2023 at Wisma Sarawak here yesterday.

The Premier proudly acknowledged TEGAS' technological advancements, citing the development of the Sigai app.

"This app, a pioneering transit signal priority system for Autonomous Rapid Transit (ART) in Southeast Asia, renews our

youth's potential. The Co-living Lodge is intended to further nurture such talents by providing them with a co-living space and facilities," he added.

Also present were Minister for Education, Higher Education and Talent Development Datuk Seri Roaldan Sagah Wee Issi and Deputy Minister of State for Land Administration and Environment Ministry of Natural Resources and Urban Development Datuk Leni Saiti Saiti.

offered better, more effectively and the work done will certainly bring a great opportunity for them to have a better future, which will ultimately contribute to the economic development of the state," he said.

Sagah said that to overcome the lack of supply in skilled manpower, the ministry will involve educational institutions and training

institutions need to work closely with the relevant industry and government to produce a workforce that meets market demands.

Meanwhile, according to Deputy Minister of Urban Planning and Land Administration and Environment Datuk Saiti Saiti, the SCAT Fair is a platform for all levels of society to find career and education based on the digital economy.

This year we were able to shift the SCAT Fair after three years of holding it online due to the COVID-19 pandemic," he said, hoping to expand it on a bigger scale in future.
