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Chairman's Message

The year 2022 marked the 10th anniversary of TEGAS. Throughout the past 10 years, TEGAS has maintained a visionary alignment with the Sarawak State Government's agenda of developing a digitalized Sarawak. From 2019 until 2021, when we experienced the COVID-19 pandemic phase within the time frame, TEGAS managed to overcome the difficulties of engaging with a broader spectrum of target groups with the usual physical programmes through its online and virtual programmes such as STEM Playground Virtual and TEGAS Pre Accelerator Boothcamp.

In accordance with the Sarawak Post-COVID Development Strategy (PCDS), most of the programmes by TEGAS were held through physical engagements and meet-ups to directly encourage active and constructive participation from the target groups. However, existing online and virtual programmes are maintained concurrently to support those who are interesin participating but are incapable of physically attending the events held.

There are a few new programmes in 2022, such as the Think & Thinker Mini LabExplorer Series and TEGAS Community Workshop, which aim to promote talent development in STEM education. Besides the existing physical programmes, TEGAS has also come up with a new online programme to increase the target group's reach out in the year 2023. Additionally, our podcast initiative, which goes by the name, TEGAS Community Podcast, focuses on showcasing the contributions made to the community by remarkable individuals, where as our own docu-series called TEGAS: A Day in Life, aims to highlight local Sarawakian talents ranging from different industries, as a way to promote our local expertise.

For the year 2022, TEGAS has a very good start for the post-COVID-19 pandemic recovery phase and a strategic plan for 2023. I do believe that TEGAS will greatly contribute and will be a key player in the Premier's aspiration of digitalizing Sarawak.


About TEGAS

Nevertheless, even in the absence of new disruptive technology, there is still a talent shortage in the conventional digital content industry across Southeast Asia Indeed, the demand for quality talent continues to exceed the supply, and this is not expected to change in Southeast Asia (SEA) and the global market.

Having said that, the opportunities for talent development in the digital content industry are extremely promising and exciting. Therefore, a study comprising a survey and interview was proposed to obtain the primary data from existing digital content players. The findings from the study, combined with reviews from other relevant sources, will be used to establish an understanding of the industry's position in the job market.

In addition, the report will also develop strategic recommendations to drive potential opportunities in talent development and equipping talent with the skill sets necessary for the Web 3.0 future.


