Chairman's Message

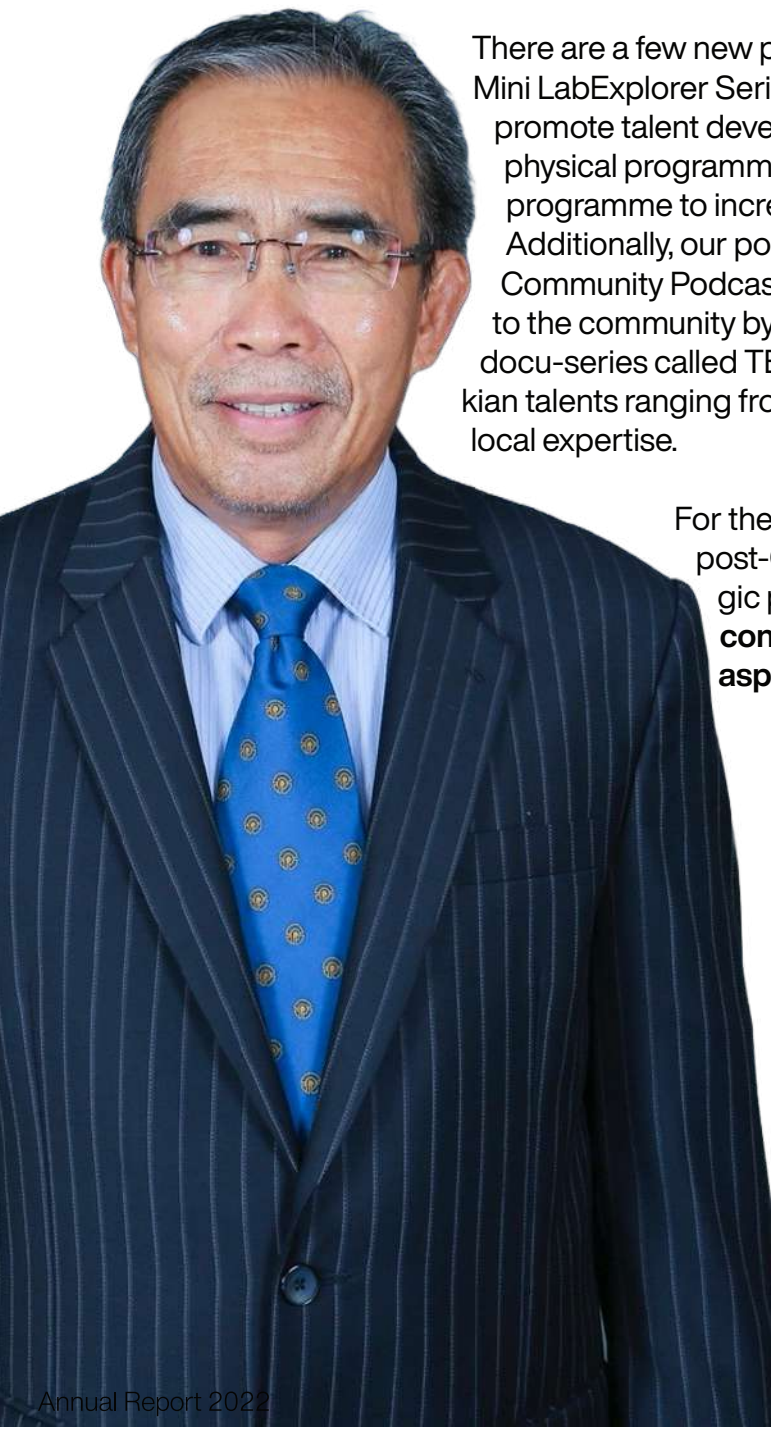

In accordance with the Sarawak Post-COVID Development Strategy (PCDS), most of the programmes by TEGAS were held through physical engagements and meet-ups to directly encourage active and constructive participation from the target groups. However, existing online and virtual programmes are maintained concurrently to support those who are interested in participating but are incapable of physically attending the events held.
