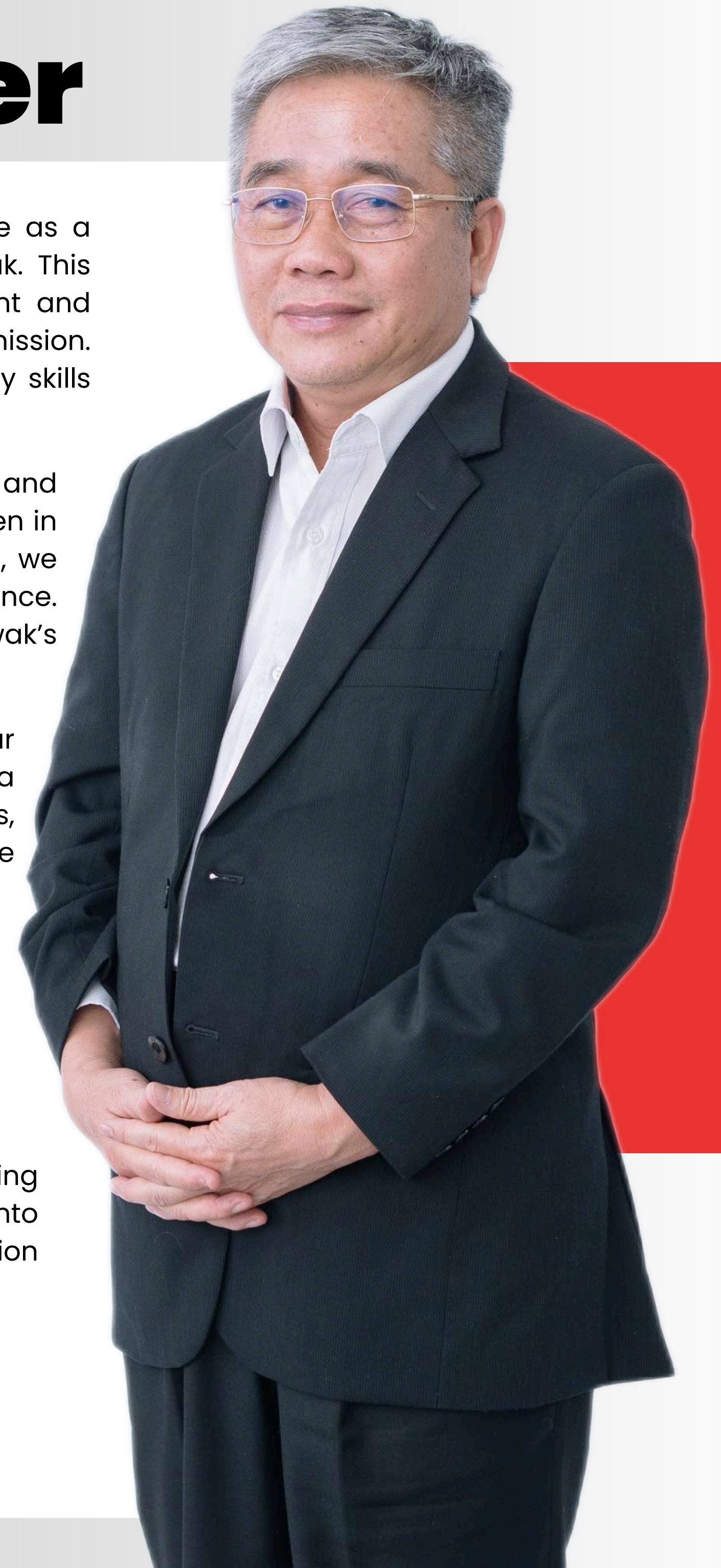

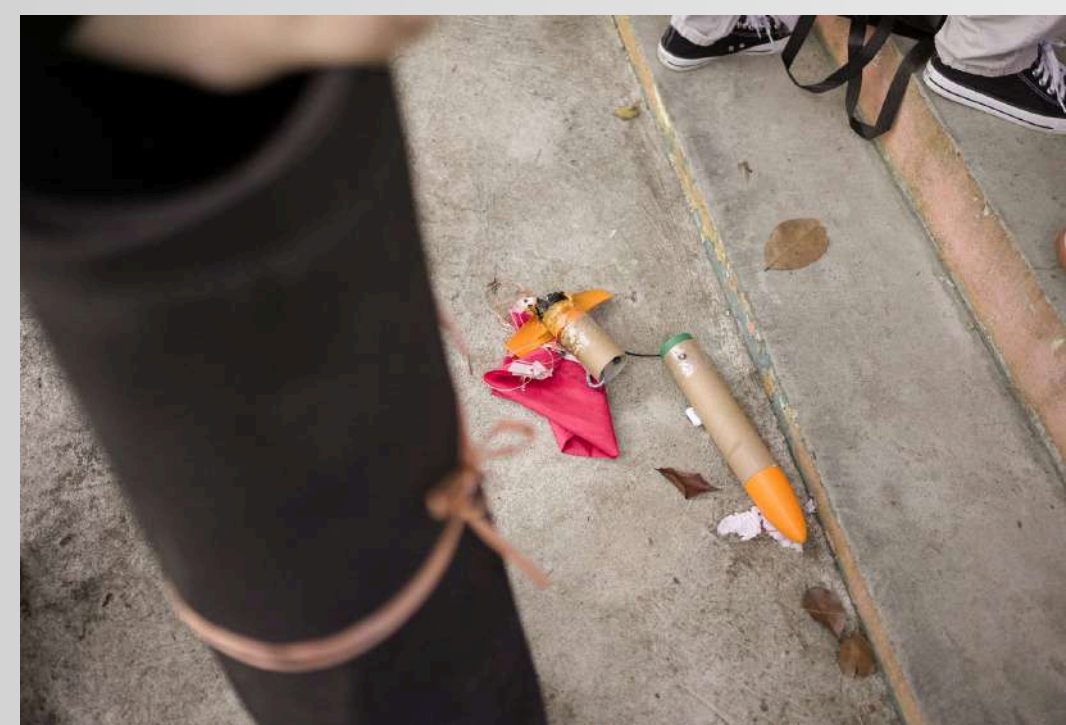
## **Strengthening Strategic Communication with UKAS**

## **SCaT Fair 2025 Official Launch**

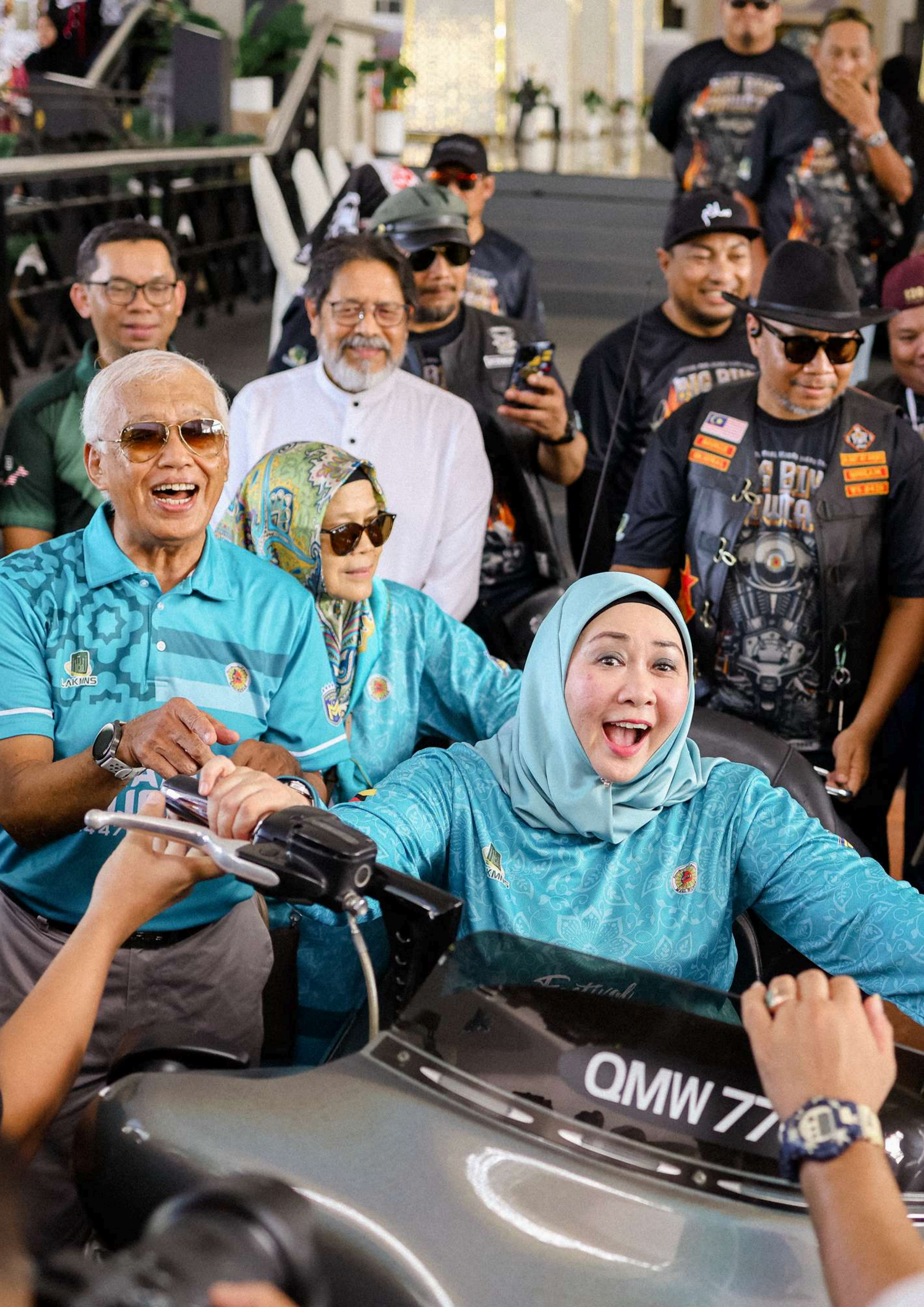
