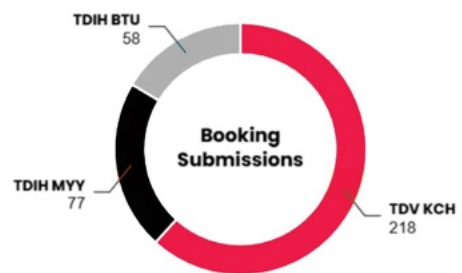

As a tenant at **TEGAS** Digital Village and alumni of **TEGAS** programmes, Teduh Jiwa, founded by registered counsellors Anis Wahida Imran and Jesynthia Wong, shared insights with **TEGAS** on their journey, innovations, and goals in advancing human-centred mental health care.



From Quiet Questions to a Community-Driven Mission

Teduh Jiwa Counselling & Consultancy, founded in May 2024 in Kuching by registered counsellors Anis Wahida Imran and Jesynthia Wong, did not begin as a business idea. It began with a few persistent questions:

Why does seeking help still feel difficult, even when support exists?

How can counselling be sustainable for practitioners while remaining accessible to those who need it most?

These questions emerged from years spent in counselling rooms, listening to stories of distress, resilience, and quiet struggles. While mental health conversations were gaining visibility, many individuals still hesitated. They feared judgement, felt unsure where to begin, or believed they were “not struggling enough” to seek professional support.

In Sarawak, these barriers were particularly pronounced. Professional services were available, but often felt distant or intimidating. Teduh Jiwa was created to change that experience.



Meeting People Where They Are

From the outset, Teduh Jiwa extended its work beyond the counselling room. The founders engaged directly with communities through educational sessions, outreach programmes, and informal conversations with students, youth, and B40 groups. What became clear was that people did not only need therapy. They needed reassurance, familiarity, and safe spaces before asking for help.

In response, Teduh Jiwa introduced gentle entry points such as free 30-minute consultations, complimentary mental health screenings, and community-based psychoeducation sessions. These initiatives were designed to ease the first step into care and normalise help-seeking behaviour.

Since its establishment, the team has observed meaningful shifts. Clients reported lighter days, improved emotional regulation, better communication, and restored confidence at work or in studies. Many returned for follow-up sessions not because they were in crisis, but because they recognised the value of ongoing support. For Teduh Jiwa, these moments affirmed a core belief: when care is accessible, respectful, and human, people will choose it.



Building Systems That Care Can Live In

Recognising that healing does not occur in isolation, Teduh Jiwa developed the WeNDI (Wellbeing Empowerment & Nurturing Diverse Individuals) Initiative, a growing ecosystem designed to support mental health beyond individual therapy. WeNDI combines counselling, psychoeducation, and community-based interventions to reach neurodivergent individuals, youth, and marginalised communities.

Programmes under WeNDI, including WeNDI.Connect, WeNDICare+, and HeART Space, provide layered pathways of support. Subsidised counselling sessions, supported by Yayasan Hasanah through the Hasanah Social Enterprise Fund 2024 and the Ministry of Finance (MOF), ensure that cost does not become a barrier to care. Workplace and community initiatives emphasise prevention, resilience-building, and long-term sustainability rather than one-off interventions.

For the team, mental health work sits at the intersection of science and care. It is structured, ethical, and evidence-based, yet deeply personal and relational.

Growing with the **TEGAS** Ecosystem

Like many early-stage social enterprises, Teduh Jiwa's journey included moments of uncertainty. A turning point came when the founders joined the **TEGAS** Pre-Accelerator Bootcamp (TPAB) Batch 6 in July 2024.

The programme provided structured exposure to entrepreneurship, sustainability, and scaling impact. Presenting at the TPAB Demo Day and emerging as one of five winning startups affirmed that ethical mental health practice and innovation can coexist. Mentorship and feedback from industry experts, reinforced the importance of safeguarding confidentiality and quality. For the founders, the experience strengthened their resolve to build carefully, intentionally, and with integrity.



Innovation with Care


Teduh Jiwa approaches innovation with care, keeping professional ethics and human connection at the centre of its work. The team is exploring how technology can responsibly support mental health practitioners, including early-stage development of a digital psychological assessment system.

This tool helps counselors better understand clients' needs and focus sessions more effectively. Technology is used as an enabler, not a replacement for care, ensuring that ethical standards, confidentiality, and human

Looking Ahead

Access remains central as Teduh Jiwa looks forward. Beyond Kuching, mental health support is still limited, particularly for rural and underserved communities. The team is exploring outreach-based approaches, including mobile counselling, community partnerships, and hybrid programmes that combine digital tools with human-centred engagement.

At its core, Teduh Jiwa is about building a mental health ecosystem, one that supports individuals, strengthens pathways for counselling professionals, and fosters collaboration across sectors. Guided by empathy, professionalism, and care, the journey continues with a simple hope: that mental health support becomes something people feel is meant for them, not something they must struggle to reach.



From Dreams to Reality: 10 Years of the Project of Dream Realised

This year, **TEGAS** marks 10 years of its flagship initiative, the Project of Dream Realised (Pro-DR) Roadshow, a transformative journey bringing opportunities directly to Sarawakian youth, especially those in rural and remote communities.

Guided by the enduring theme, "From Dreams to Reality," Pro-DR has opened doors to education, career pathways, and digital innovation, helping students navigate higher education, TVET, and emerging industries. Over the past decade, it has inspired thousands to dream bigger, aim higher, and shape meaningful futures across Sarawak.



What began in 2015 as a bold effort to bridge the educational gap has grown into a statewide movement of opportunity and inspiration. Over the past decade, Pro-DR has reached thousands of students, parents, and teachers across Sarawak, bringing guidance, exposure, and future-ready insights directly to rural communities.

In 2025 alone, the programme visited 14 districts, engaging over 5,000 attendees across Lawas, Limbang, Long Lama, Sebauh, Mukah, Daro, Tanjung Manis, Kapit, Bintangor, Saratok, Balai Ringin, Sebuyau, Siburan, and Lundu.

Since its inception, Pro-DR has travelled to more than 30 districts statewide, including Sarikei, Sri Aman, Niah, Belaga, Miri, Bintulu, Serian, Padawan, Meradong, Belawai, Bau, Simunjan, Lubok Antu, Kanowit, Bekenu, Betong, Marudi, Sibul, Baram, Song, and Julau. Even during the COVID-19 pandemic, **TEGAS** ensured continuity through the PRO-DR e-EXPO 2021. "Education should not be confined to urban centres. Our mission is to bring knowledge, tools, and inspiration directly to students, giving them a fair chance to explore and dream big," emphasised **TEGAS** Chairman, The Honorable Datuk Len Talif Salleh.

Over the years, Pro-DR has evolved beyond a roadshow into a capacity-building platform, connecting students with education pathways, career opportunities, and Sarawak's rapidly expanding digital ecosystem under PCDS 2030. Through on-ground counselling, exhibitions by government agencies, educational and training institutions, and financial aid providers, as well as hands-on exposure, the programme ensures no student is left behind, regardless of geography. "After a decade of implementation, Pro-DR has received overwhelming support in every location," added Datuk Len Talif Salleh. "This reflects the importance of **TEGAS'** continuous efforts to ensure equal access to information and opportunities for a brighter future."

Objectives of Pro-DR

- Support Sarawakian school leavers, particularly from rural areas, in realising their dreams through accessible education pathways.
- Encourage youths to pursue technical, vocational, and higher education.
- Provide clear information on scholarships, financial aid, and free education opportunities.
- Raise awareness about TVET, STEM, and digital innovation within Sarawak's digital economy.

A Decade of Dreams Realised

Over the past ten years, Pro-DR has left a trail of inspiration in every district it visits. The roadshow has delivered more than brochures and booths; it has delivered hope, opportunity, and belief.

As **TEGAS** commemorates this milestone, the Project of Dream Realised stands as a testament to its unwavering commitment to nurturing Sarawak's next generation of innovators and changemakers, empowering dreams, inspiring progress, and building a brighter future for all.
